Hazard Communication Program

Last Revised 01/08/20

I. COMPANY POLICY

JBH Construction Inc. is committed to the prevention of exposures that result in injury and/or illness; and to comply with all applicable state health and safety rules. Under this program employees are informed of the contents of the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, the hazardous properties of the chemicals with which they work, safe handling procedures and measures to take to protect themselves from these chemicals. To make sure that all affected employees know about information concerning the dangers of all hazardous chemicals used by JBH Construction Inc. the following hazard communication program has been established. This written program will be available in the Safety Manager's office and each job foreman's vehicle for review by any interested employee.

All work units of JBH Construction Inc. will participate in the hazard communication program.

II. CONTAINER LABELING

The Safety Manager is responsible for container labeling procedures, reviewing, and updating. The labeling system used at JBH Construction Inc. is as follows:

Labeling will follow the requirements in the 2012 revision of the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard to be consistent with the United Nations Globally Harmonized System(GHS) of Classification of Labeling Chemicals. The label on the chemical/material is intended to convey information about the hazards posed by the chemical through standardized label elements, including symbols, signal words and hazard statements.

All hazardous chemical containers used at this workplace will have:

- The original manufacturer's label that includes a product identifier, an appropriate signal word, hazard statement(s), pictogram(s), precautionary statements(s), and the name, address, and telephone numbers of the chemical manufacturer, importer, or other responsible party
- A label with the appropriate label elements just described
- Work place labeling that includes the product identifier and words, pictures, symbols, or combination that provides at least general information regarding the hazards of the chemicals.

Small quantities intended for immediate use may be placed in a portable container without a label from labeled containers, provided that the individual keeps it in their possession at all times and the product is used up during the work shift or properly disposed of at the end of the work day. However, the container should be marked with its contents.

III. SAFETY DATA SHEETS (SDS)

The Safety Manager is responsible for establishing and monitoring JBH Construction Inc. SDS program. The Safety Manager will make sure procedures are developed to obtain the necessary SDSs and will review incoming SDSs for new or significant health and safety information. The Safety Manager will make certain that any new information is passed on to affected employees.

The procedures to obtain SDSs and review incoming SDSs for new or significant health and safety information are as follows:

- Safety Manager will review and request manufacturer SDS on any new product used by JBI Construction Inc. and periodically review current SDS sheets for revised versions.
- Upon receipt of new or revised SDS data the information will be entered into JBI's electronic Safety/SDS manual. This electronic manual is a shared document accessible by all JBI office, shop and field foremen by clicking the Google drive link saved to their mobile phones. Hard copies of any new or revised SDS data will be provided on a weekly basis with the employees' paycheck for incorporation into the physical copy of the manual maintained by the onsite project foremen

Copies of SDSs for all hazardous chemicals in use will be kept in JBI's front office and shop. SDSs will be available to all employees during each work shift. If an SDS is not available or a new chemical in use does not have an SDS, immediately contact the Safety Manager. SDS Manual will be updated on an annual basis.

IV. EMPLOYEE INFORMATION AND TRAINING

The Safety Manager will make sure that before starting work, each new employee of JBI Construction Inc. will attend a health and safety orientation that includes information and training on the following:

- An overview of the requirements contained in the Hazard Communication Standard.
- Hazardous chemicals present at his or her work places.
- Physical and health risks of the hazardous chemical.
- The symptoms of overexposure.
- How to determine the presence or release of hazardous chemicals in his or her work area.
- How to reduce or prevent exposure to hazardous chemicals through use of control procedures, work practices, and personal protective equipment.
- Steps JBI Construction Inc. has taken to reduce or prevent exposure to hazardous chemicals.
- Procedures to follow if employees are overexposed to hazardous chemicals.
- How to read labels and review SDSs to obtain hazard information.
- Location of the SDS file and written hazard communication program.

Before introducing a new chemical hazard into any section of this employer, each employee in that section will be given information and training as outlined above for the new chemical.

After attending the training, employees will sign a form verifying that they understand the above topics and how the topics are related to our hazard communication plans.

V. HAZARDOUS NON-ROUTINE TASKS

Periodically, employees are required to perform hazardous non-routine tasks. Non-routine tasks that are performed at JBI Construction Inc. include:

1. Confined space entry – such as manholes that require grouting or epoxy joint sealants

Prior to starting work on such projects, each affected employee will be given information by the jobsite foreman about the hazardous chemicals he or she may encounter during these activities:

- Contact of materials or dust/fumes/vapors may cause skin irritation, eye irritation, breathing issues. Harmful if swallowed.
- Avoid breathing dust, fumes, gas, direct contact with the skin, and ingestion. Follow manufactures directions for mixing, applying, etc. Do not use in enclosed space with no ventilation/fresh air supply to ensure that occupational exposure limit is not exceeded.
- JBI supplies and requires the use of personal protection devices, such as safety glass, gloves, and particulate respirators for safe handling and application of materials. Secondary attendant is required when any employee of JBI is working in a confined space. Fresh water for washing hands/arms, rinsing of the eye and drinking should employee come in direct contact is on jobsite. Employees are reminded to utilize supplied water to wash hands/face when finished handling materials and prior to eating, drinking or smoking.

VI. MULTI-EMPLOYER WORK PLACES

It is the responsibility of the Safety Manager to provide employers of any other employees at the work site with the following information:

- Copies of SDSs (or make them available at a central location) for any hazardous chemicals that the other employer(s)' employee may be exposed to while working.
- Inform other employers of any precautionary measures that need to be taken to protect employees during normal operating conditions or in foreseeable emergencies.
- Provide other employers with an explanation of the labeling system that is used at the work site.

It is also the responsibility of the Safety Manager to identify and obtain SDSs for the chemicals the sub-contractor is bringing into the work place. Onsite foreman should advise the office of any materials used that are not a part of JBI Construction Inc. hazard communication plan so necessary SDS information can be obtained and distributed.

VII. LIST OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS

The attached table lists all known hazardous chemicals with a potential for employee exposure used at this workplace. Detailed information about physical, health, and other hazards of each chemical is included in the Safety Data Sheet(SDS); the product identifier for each chemical on the list matches and can be easily cross-referenced with the product identifier on its label and on its Safety Data Sheet. A copy of this information may be obtained by reviewing SDSs located at the Front Office, Shop and each jobsite Foreman's truck. This list will be updated with each new product used by this workplace and distributed both electronically and hard copies to incorporate into the Hazard Communications Manual. HCM will be reviewed and updated annually as well.
